Experts speculate whether global growth during the period 1989 to 2008 was the result of endogenous reforms, or simply loose monetary policy and massive speculative bubbles. Questions about how markets should be organized in the future, and what form the global market economy will take when growth returns and the crisis wanes, have now become central to economic dialogue, as well as the focus of the **Return of History: From Consensus to Crisis** international conference.

The one and a half day event is a forum for researchers, policy experts and analysts from academia, economic policy research institutes, international organizations and financial institutions.
